\*\* "New students" include students that did not attend Valley Union school last year. Students that have just moved in to the area, that are changing schools from another high school district, or students that are coming from other states are "new students." Parents and guardians, please plan to meet with school employees at 2:30pm. Bring with you a copy of your child's birth certificate, immunization records, proof of residence, and transcripts that you would like us to consider. Also, please plan on possible placement testing for English and Math courses (45-90 minutes). (Students that were in the 8th grade last year in Elfrida, Pearce, McNeal, or Ash Creek elementary schools, that have taken the 9th grade math placement test and have completed a 9th grade pre-registration form are NOT considered new students)
